An endo-perio lesion is treated by knowing which component, endodontic or periodontic, is primarily involved. A dentist first accesses the tooth by palpating the surrounding soft tissue, checking if the tooth is mobile and percussing it to determine the extent of pain. Checking the presence, extent and depth of the periodontal pockets is done through an instrument called the periodontal probe.
