Surgery for Rectal Cancer. Surgery is usually the main treatment for rectal cancer. Radiation and chemotherapy are often given before or after surgery. The type of surgery used depends on the stage (extent) of the cancer, where it is, and the goal of the surgery. A key piece of information needed before surgery is how close the tumor is to the anus.

Surgery for Rectal Cancer

The anus, rectum and part of the sigmoid colon are removed to include the attending vessels and lymph nodes. The end of the colon is then brought through an opening made in the abdominal wall (this is called a colostomy). Small Bowel Resection: This surgery is performed to remove Crohn's disease, cancer, ulcers, benign tumors, and polyps. This surgery removes a portion of the small intestine.

Remove the dressing the morning after the surgery and then get in a warm tub. Apply Silvadene cream to anus after each hot bath for the first seven to 10 days. After bathing, pat dry or use a hair dryer. After each bowel movement, gently cleanse the area with water or bathe/shower to keep the area clean.

The part of the rectum closest to the colon is called the upper rectum, while the part of the rectum closest to the anus is called the lower rectum. Local transanal resection or excision: This surgery is used to remove early stage rectal cancers in the lower rectum. It is performed by instruments inserted through the rectum.

Your surgeon will remove most of your rectum and attach the bowel (colon) to your anus. Sometimes your surgeon will create a pouch by folding

back a small section of colon or by enlarging a section of the bowel (colon). This small pouch works like the rectum did before surgery. This operation is called a colo anal anastomosis.

A surgeon may core out the tract and then cut a flap into the rectal wall to access and remove the fistula's internal opening then stitches the flap back down.
